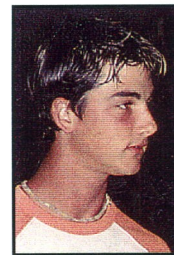

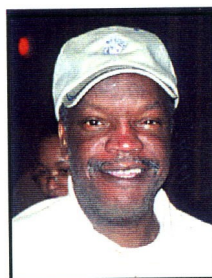
● **Business Meeting** Our annual Saturday Reunion Business Meeting went off on the day after Friday. We figured out stuff and voted to return to Texas for 2005.

SATURDAY EVENING BANQUET

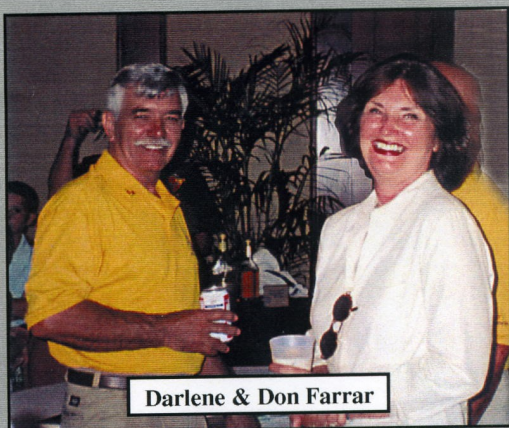

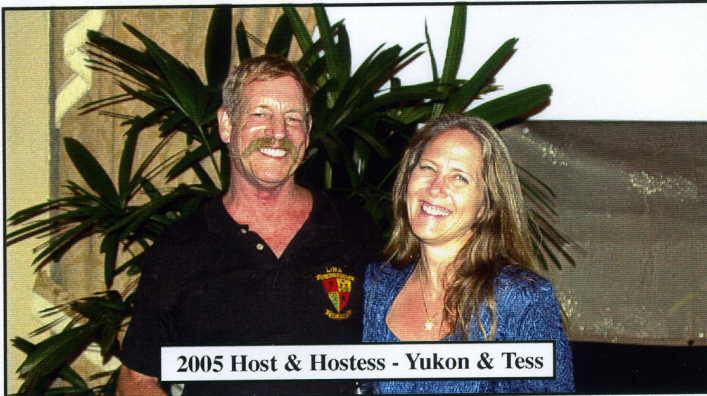


EXTENDED FAMILY

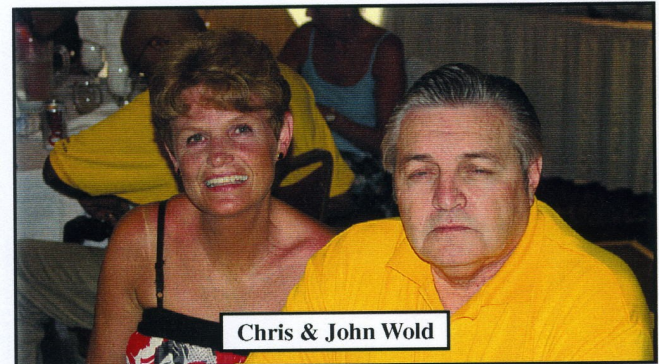
