Complimentary transportation to Fashion Valley, Old Town and the San Diego Trolley.

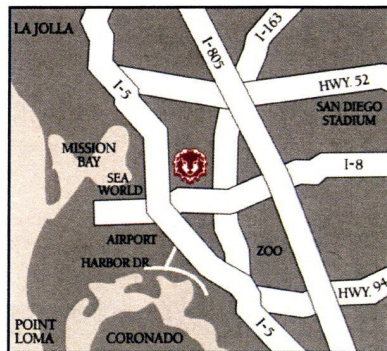
ACCOMMODATIONS:
