

We toured the Paris Island Museum,




and saw a couple of Boots.

I was wounded twice while calling in medevacs, once in June 1969 and again in September 1969. I never received my Purple Heart Certificate until a few years ago, after requesting it. At that time I found out that I only was awarded one Purple Heart, the one for September. Apparently, the one for June was called in wrong. If someone remembers that night (the 1st medivac in got shot down), I would like to hear from them, and maybe get the second Purple Heart. It seems to mean more to me now then it did years ago.
